Week starting 6th August	Special event: COMPASSION SUNDAY Students learn about: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Children and how they live around the world, in particular learning about people less fortunate than us. Week starting 13th August	Rescue Complete → Exodus 11-14 Students learn about: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • God showed he was powerful and trustworthy. Students learn to: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Appreciate from the Bible that Jesus has rescued his followers from their sins by dying on the cross and rising again. 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Week starting 20th August	<p>God teaches his people→ Exodus 19-20</p> <p>Students learn about:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> How God told his people how to live because he loves them and wants the best for them. <p>Students learn to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> State ways in which they can show love to each other. 	What do we learn about God from this?	'The Lord has promised that he will not leave or desert us.' Hebrews 13:5
Week starting 27th August	<p>God lives with his people → Exodus 25:1-9, 40:34-38</p> <p>Students learn about:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> How God wanted his people to know he was with them. <p>Students learn to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> State how God shows that he still lives with his people today. 	Who can remember all the amazing things that happened in the story?	'The Lord has promised that he will not leave or desert us.' Hebrews 13:5
Week starting 3rd September	<p>God's people rebel → Numbers 13-14</p> <p>Students learn about:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> How the people lacked trust in their God, who had protected them. <p>Students learn to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Understand from this part of the bible that God can be trusted to do what he promises. 	What are some things that make us nervous?	'The Lord has promised that he will not leave or desert us.' Hebrews 13:5
Week starting 10th September	<p>Remember The Rescue→ Deuteronomy 4-11; 28-29, 30:11-20</p> <p>Students learn about:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> How the bible tells people how God wants them to live their lives. <p>Students learn to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Identify things for which they can be thankful for. 	What they are thankful for?	'The Lord has promised that he will not leave or desert us.' Hebrews 13:5
Week starting 17th September	<p>Into the Promised Land→ Joshua 1-6</p> <p>Students learn about:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> How the people trusted and obeyed God and how God was faithful. <p>Students learn to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Give reasons for why Christians believe that God can do anything. 	God promises to be with his people who love and trust Jesus. Think of a situation where someone would like Jesus to be with them.	'The Lord has promised that he will not leave or desert us.' Week starting 24th September	<p>Jesus the rescuer</p> <p>Students learn about:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> How God is still fulfilling his promises. <p>Students learn to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Understand the parallels between the Old Testament stories and God's plan for people's lives now.
